

In an effort to help contain the resurgence of COVID-19 cases, we'd like to remind you of some things you can do to mitigate the spread while in the workplace.

When using common areas (bathrooms, kitchen, meeting rooms, etc.), please take extra caution to protect yourself. In addition to wearing a mask in all common areas and when you are unable to socially distance appropriately (made mandatory by NJ Executive Order 192), you can reduce the spread of germs through frequent handwashing and sanitization and using disposable paper towels on door handles, etc.

For those that wish to be more socially distanced during lunch or breaks while in Basking Ridge, please be reminded that the downstairs bar area is being cleaned daily and prepared for alternative use.

Additionally, with the holidays quickly approaching, please keep in mind many states are designated as having significant community spread and quarantine measures must be taken when returning to NJ from traveling during this time.
